On behalf of Plumas Crisis Intervention & Resource Center (PCIRC), and the many individuals, families, and children of Plumas County, we send our heartfelt thanks to each one of you and collectively to The Robert Nelson Foundation for your generous donation.

In July of 2021, Plumas County was devastated by Northern California's Dixie Fire which burned nearly 1 million acres and destroyed over 1,300 structures in our rural communities. This fire represented the second largest blaze in California history and the first ever to burn from one side of the Sierra Nevada to the other. Three historical communities were devastated in this battle, and many lost all their belongings and their place in this world.

Our agency assisted over 1,200 individuals working as emergency responders and we continue today to support the many needs for those rebuilding their lives.
